

FAQ for NDFT Renewals

Quickly get answers to your questions regarding NDFT renewals.

1. When will I receive the NDFT Renewal Policies?

NDIRF member and agent renewal policies will be mailed the last week of June. It is your responsibility to distribute the member policy to the member for which you're the AOR.

2. What am I expected to provide?

- For existing property, complete the attached Building Property Information Collection Form and submit to NDFT@ndirf.com.
- For new property (Building Property, Personal Property, Outdoor Property), complete appropriate application found here: <https://www.ndirf.com/member-services/nd-fire-tornado/ft-coverage-forms-and-applications>.

To ensure member property is adequately scheduled and covered, we recommend you submit updated photos of each piece of property covered under NDFT to NDFT@ndirf.com.

3. Where can I access NDFT forms and applications?

4. How will the member be billed?

NDFT policies will be agency billed in the same way they are billed for NDIRF coverage. All outstanding balances before renewal will need to be reconciled directly by the member.

5. Are there different deductible options?

No, the deductibles for each member are determined by the total insured value of the members. Deductible options are slated to be available for the 2021/2022 renewal.

6. How is outdoor property valued?

All outdoor property is valued at actual cash value (ACV). Updated valuation options are slated to be available for the 2021/2022 renewal. Outdoor property includes but is not limited to fencing, detached lights/poles, flag poles, detached signs, monuments/statues, and bleachers (unless part of a grandstand). 7. Does NDFT cover Builders Risk?

No, NDFT does not have a Builders Risk option.
