



In early December 1985, Ward County became the first member of Missouri River Underwriters' new governmental risk pool, the North Dakota Insurance Reserve Fund (NDIRF). By the end of 1985, a few additional entities - Valley City, Mandan, and Max - also became members. The founders understood the value the NDIRF could bring to North Dakota, but skeptics and proponents alike were surprised by how quickly the NDIRF took off.
